Tuesday, October 25, 2011: Our debut lecture will feature Manuel Jordán, Ph.D, Chief Curator and Director of Collections at Arizona's *Musical Instrument Museum (MIM)*. Dr. Jordan has primary responsibility for the African and Latin American collections and he has done extensive field research on art and culture in Zambia and Botswana. Plan to visit the MIM this fall, too!

Tuesday, November 15, 2011: Allan J. Hamilton, M.D., will share some of the lessons he has learned from patients about the importance of addressing the emotional as well as physical needs of those being treated. Both the body and soul are in need of intensive care in the midst of a health crisis. Come hear *The Spiritual Journey of a Reluctant Surgeon – Lessons from Medicine Learned the Hard Way*.

Tuesday, January 10, 2012: Our first speaker of 2012 will be Dr. Stephen Kent Happel, Associate Dean and Professor in the College of Business at ASU. He will begin with the most recent Blue Chip consensus forecasts for 2012-2013, followed by state job growth numbers and address various policy issues. Don't miss *Devastation by the Big Three: The Fed, Congress and the White House*.

Tuesday, February 28, 2012: Eduardo Pagan, ASU's Bob Stump Endowed Professor of History and host of the popular PBS series "History Detectives," is our featured Arizona Centennial speaker. He will provide historical context and share behind-the-scenes stories for two investigations on Arizona history. Join us for *Mysteries of Arizona*.

All of the lectures will be presented at the Holland Community Center. Registrations starts at 6:30 PM and the lectures begin promptly at 7:00 PM followed by an active question and answer session. You are welcome to remain after the program to talk with the speaker. We conclude around 8:30 PM.
